## Landscape Photography Courses

No previous experience needed but you will get more out of the course if you have a few negatives of your own.

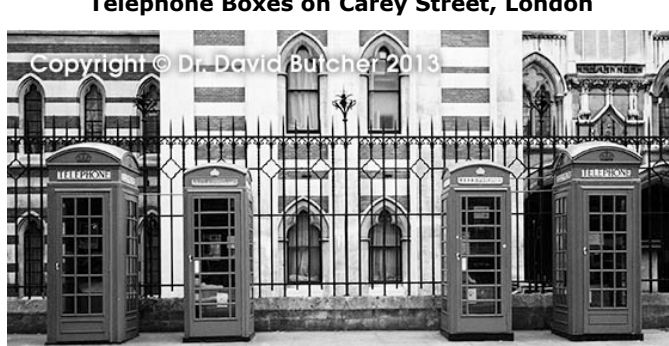
## Experience Film Photography and Darkroom Course

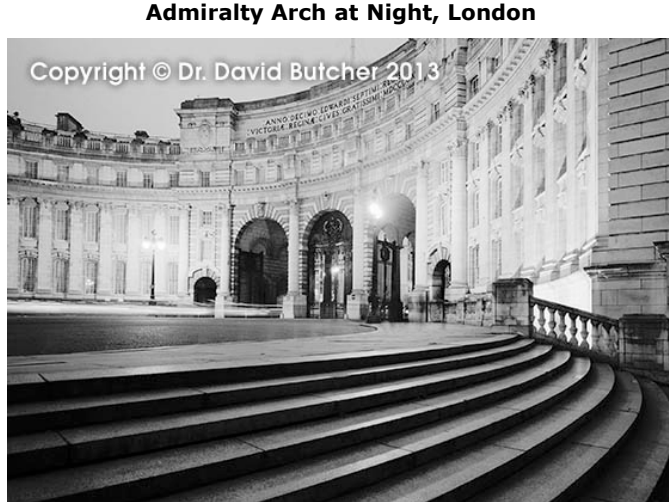

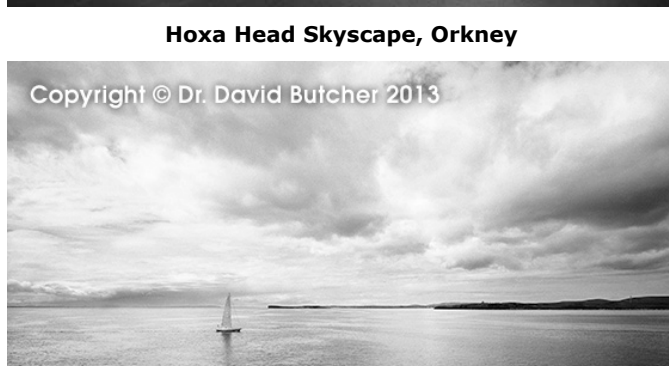

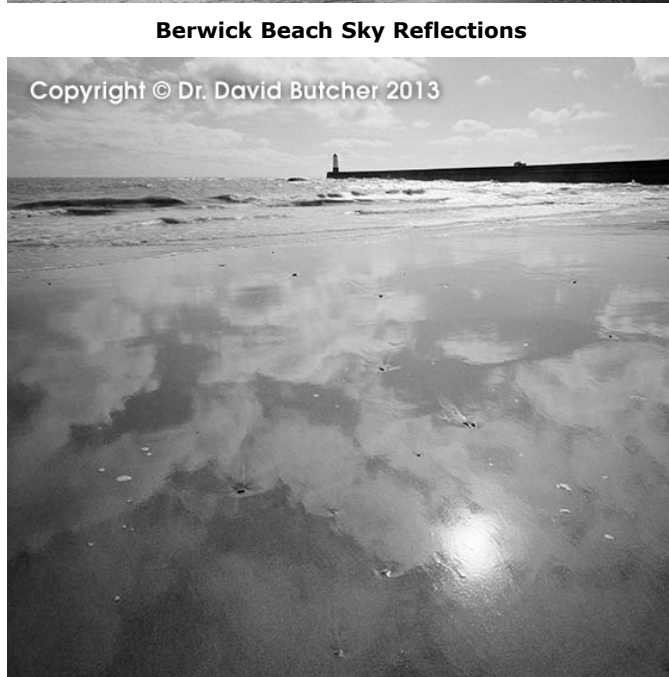
