My new book City Light went to the printers last week and we took delivery today! We think it looks great but wait to hear your views. There are 123 images from 30 cities around the world, and Buxton. It will be available for ± 15 from my web site from 2nd March and through Amazon Marketplace once they make the ISBN available for me to set it up, hopefully within a week or two as the ISBN registration was completed several weeks ago.





We will launch City Light at the Focus on Imaging show at the Birmingham NEC from Sunday 3rd March 2013. <u>Ilford Photo</u> / <u>Harman Technology</u> have generously agreed to have us on their stand for the launch (C2, Hall 9). We also have some 7 darkroom prints of images from the book making a small exhibition. There will be an introductory offer for the 4 show days.

Landscape Photography Courses

Our courses offer full days of practical photography, no classroom sessions, just 5 people with 2 tutors (Dave and Jan Butcher) in an enjoyable atmosphere. We cover both black and white and colour between us and they are suitable for complete beginners to advanced photographers, for digital and film cameras. Darkroom Printing Courses

The darkroom printing courses are £160 per place and include all paper and chemicals. Ilford subsidise the cost of the paper and chemicals used on the courses for which there is no extra charge. There are 2 places on each course so you are assured of lots of attention during the day. No previous experience needed but you will get more out of the course if you have a few negatives of your own.

New Photographs

Here are a few new images that have been added to the web site since the last newsletter. The USA landscapes were all taken in January 2012. The aerial shots were taken from a light aircraft after a friend unbelievably and generously offered to take us up over the Rockies near Steamboat Springs, rather like we would offer to go for a drive in the Peak District! I tried to make them a bit more abstract, looking for patterns and textures in the landscape below. I can take shots from mountain tops that look like aerial shots as long as I don't put anything in the foreground! These are a bit different. more to add when I find time. There were a lot of vibrations so I had to shoot with the fastest shutter speed my Mamiya 7 and Ilford FP4 could manage. Even so not all were pin-sharp.
