

I have also written an article on city and night photography so that you can go out and take similar shots. The full title is 'City Light - Cities of the World and Buxton by Dave Butcher'. Ilford Photo/Harman Technology have kindly agreed to have Jan and I on their stand (C2, Hall 9) at the Focus on Imaging show at the Birmingham NEC starting Sunday 3rd March 2013. We will launch City Light here and have a continuous book signing for 4 days. I'm in training already! Our part of the stand will be decorated with some framed hand prints of city photos from the book.

Our courses offer full days of practical photography, no classroom sessions, just 5 people with 2 tutors (Dave and Jan Butcher) in an enjoyable atmosphere. We cover both black and white and colour between us and they are suitable for complete beginners to advanced photographers, for digital and film cameras. 







Photo Tips

We have had quite a bit of snow now. Lots of road closures in the Peak District so not easy to move around but walking near your house could give you some interesting shots. Sunshine every now and then to brighten things too. When it's dull though look for little bits in the landscape where snow makes a difference. Snow sitting on fences and gates, animal tracks in the snow leading to some shapely trees, ice on rocks in the river beds, those sort of things. When the sun comes back know what you want to take and go for it, you may not have long! Check you don't over-expose, sun reflected off snow tends to do this. Easily checked on digital cameras, look at the histogram (use your manual to find this if unfamiliar to you) and move it away from the right hand side or check for flashing highlights; either way reduce exposure manually to compensate.
